

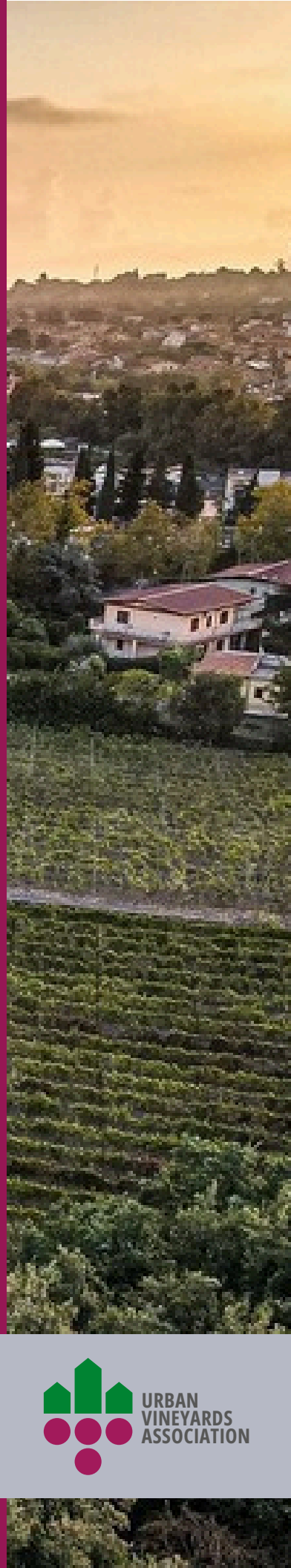

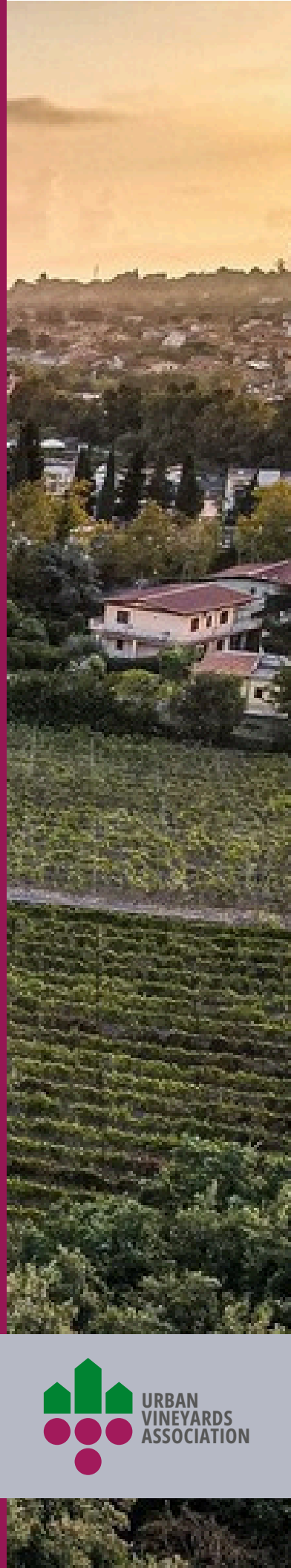

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## FROM THE PRESIDENT

**The Urban Vineyards Association (U.V.A.)** was born with the aim of protecting the rural, historical and natural heritage represented by urban vineyards, enhancing their awareness and unlocking their touristic and wine making potential (although not all vineyards are wine producing).

Wine production in urban vineyards is peculiar, especially due to the close proximity of households requiring a tailored approach to vineyard management, often set as organic, and peculiar problems such as reduced direct sunlight and city birds attacks in some cases.

Urban wines sometimes face a prejudice: being city born, they cannot be high quality as those produced in the countryside. This initiative is to challenge this perception: soil, weather conditions and wine making skills drives wine quality regardless if the surroundings of a vineyard are build-up.

The catalogue presents a comprehensive selection of wines produced with grapes coming from Urban Vineyards part of our association, including some non-commercial wines produced for cultural purposes only.

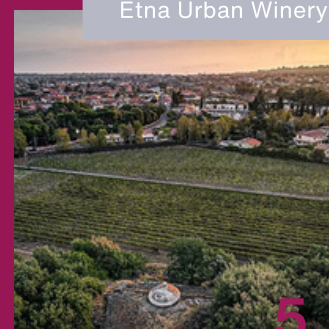

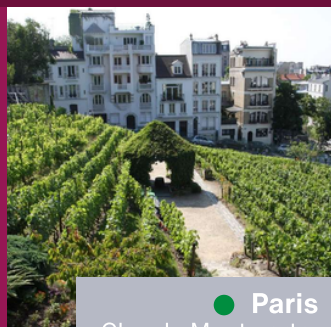

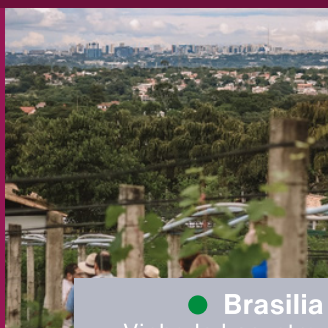

## Patritti

Patritti Wines is an historical Adelaide based winery, dedicated to preserving South Australia's urban viticultural heritage. Since 2006, they have managed the historic Marion Vineyard, established in 1907, and later revived the nearby Warriparinga and Oaklands Estate Vineyards, once-neglected sites now back to wine production.

These vineyards, part of Patritti's Urban Vineyard Collection, reflect a unique blend of tradition, innovation, and sustainability, with all wines grown, made, and bottled locally—honoring a legacy that began with Giovanni Patritti in 1926.

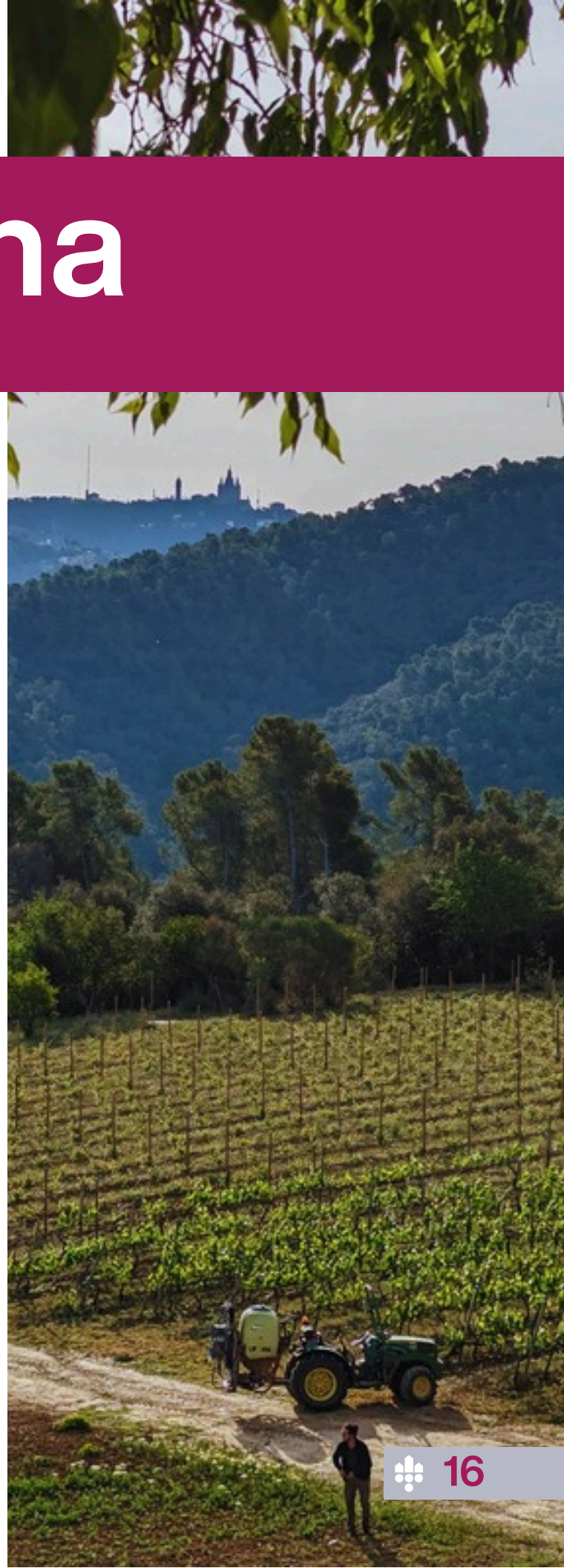
## Masia Can Calopa de Dalt

# Bolzano

## Nusserhof

Nusserhof is a 3.5-hectare oasis nestled within the urban landscape of Bolzano, in the Alto Adige region. Rooted in alluvial and porphyry soils nourished by the Isarco River, their vines—some over 80 years old—grow exclusively native varieties: Lagrein, Teroldego, and the rare Blatterle. Once on the brink of extinction, Blatterle was revived by Heinrich, Gloria's father, who propagated the last ten surviving vines. Today, half a hectare is dedicated to preserving this historical gem.

Since 1994, the estate has been certified organic, embracing a low-intervention approach to winemaking—relying solely on indigenous yeasts and allowing each wine to mature at its own pace, often up to four years, to achieve harmony and depth. Nusserhof's legacy is also deeply tied to the memory of Josef Mayr-Nusser, Gloria's great-uncle, who was executed for refusing to swear allegiance to Hitler and later beatified by Pope Francis in 2017. His courage continues to inspire the soul behind every bottle.

# Brasilia

## Vinhedo Lacustre

Vinhedo Lacustre began in 1996 with a deep love for the land, when the owner's father planted a grapevine on a property overlooking Brasília. Despite the region's rainy summers, a breakthrough in the 2000s—known as the “double pruning” technique—enabled quality grape production during the dry winters.

In 2010, the family planted a hectare of vines, including Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot, and Lorena, originally for personal use. After health issues in 2020, Marcos Ritter took over to fulfill his father's dream, releasing their first wine in 2021 and opening the vineyard to visitors in 2022. Today, Vinhedo Lacustre is a key wine tourism destination in Brasília, offering tastings, picnics, and Italian cuisine, all rooted in family heritage and passion.

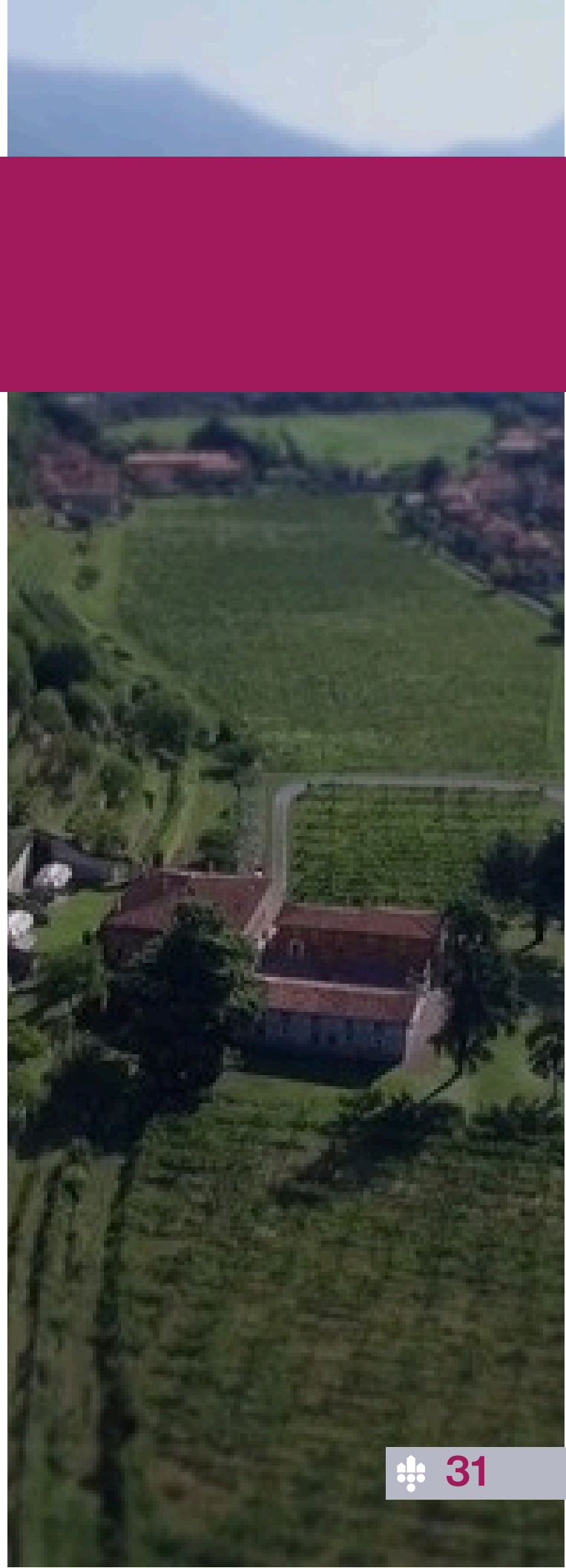
# Brescia

## Tenuta Villa Badia Piccola

Tenuta Villa Badia Piccola, located in the municipality of Brescia within the Parco delle Colline Bresciane and protected since 1992 as an area of notable landscape value, combines history and winemaking tradition with sustainable practices. With roots in wine production dating back to the 19th century and earlier monastic cultivation, it preserves a 17th-century cellar and vines over 70 years old, renewed in 2019 to maintain the site's ampelographic memory. Surrounded by dry-stone walls in the French clos style, the estate produces a Merlot blended with 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, whose label features Roberto Tanghetti's artwork Medusa, thus reflecting its rural, historical, and artistic heritage.

**There is no evidence of heavy metals residuals in finished wines produced from urban vineyards. Many of the vineyards are also managed following organic farming protocols. We also like to highlight the role of urban vineyards in mitigating pollution and their positive impact on cities**
